



SWAP MODELERS FEBRUARY MEETING MINUTES

GENERAL NOTES

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm on Feb 15 at the old K-Mart store, Bob Pollokoff, president, presiding. There was some concern about not having a quorum to conduct business and hold nominations, but since all present officers were running unopposed, the meeting proceeded.

Art Vail brought us up to date on the progress of the raffle plane, a Hanger 9 Taylorcraft. Tom Kowalski is building it and plans to have it finished some time in March. Dave Parkison of HobbyTown is donating the plane and Art offered to print the raffle tickets himself which will amount to considerable savings to the club.

SHOW AND TELL

Art Vail showed the completed Giles that he has been working on. He finished the cowl and wheel pants with a hand rubbed lacquer finish. He also increased the wing trailing edge and aileron area. Art also showed the wing of a 33% Giles that Doc and Ralph built for him. He is modeling it after a full size Giles that is flown by a team in Germany. The full size plane features wing fairings, so Art has built fairings into his planes wings also. He plans to have it completed by April.

Doc showed a 60 size Kaos that he rebuilt from a crashed plane that was given to him by Wayne Bury. He put about 100 hours into it and is powering it with an OS 61 FSR helicopter engine. He said it was a very enjoyable snowy day project. Wayne Bury showed off his Christmas present, a 500 size scale model of the French built Augusta 109 helicopter. It features retracts and running lights and will have Gauvi mechanicals in it. Power will be supplied by a 6cell 22vt 3000 mah battery system.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:35. 13 members attended.
