Demitre Avramov showed a scratch built glider using a solid fuel rocket engine as a launch booster giving it an altitude of up to 1000 ft. depending on the engine used. It could also be discus launched. The wings were built of fibreglassed foam using the vacuum bag method with the colors being applied in the mold. A very unique looking craft.
